Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was discovered in the Four's Classroom there was a bottle of cleaning solution sitting on the teacher's desk and accessible to the children. It was explained that this mixture inside the bottle had been mixed in accordance with CDC guidelines and was non-toxic. This solution was in an unlabeled spray container and there was no way for surveyor to confirm that this solution was non-toxic and did not have to be kept out of the reach of children.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was found that in the bathroom attached to the Four's Classroom, the exhaust fan was detached and hanging from the ceiling. It was also discovered that in the bathroom attached to the Four's 2 Classroom, the fan was caked with dust.

General: Based on observation, it was found that in the Infant Classroom there was a large scuff with chipped paint on the wall on the right as you enter the room. In the Two's Classroom chipped paint was observed on the blue wall and the back white wall. It was also discovered that in the Four's Classroom there were chipped paint spots on the purple wall
