- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

435 - Training

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff hired on 9/26/2013, only completed 13 of the fifteen cabinet-approved early care and education training hours between 7/01/2020 and 6/30/2021.
- 2. A staff hired on 11/23/2015, only completed 14.50 of the fifteen cabinet-approved early care and education training hours between 7/01/2020 and 6/30/2021.

The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed these findings.
