**3. After toileting or diaper change;**  
**4. After handling animals;**  
**5. After touching an item or an area of the body soiled with body fluids or wastes; and**  
**6. After outdoor or indoor play time; and**  
**(c) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection. The child shall wash the child's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.**

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to comply with hygienic practices in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon observation at 09:30 a.m., two (2) pre-school children entered the cafeteria from exiting the school bus; however, the children were not assisted or prompted in hand washing procedures before eating their breakfast.
