210 - Licensee Responsibility (1) A licensee shall:

- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a female child in Room 112 (EHS) was observed wearing amber colored beads around her neck. An interview with staff found that the beads are Amber Teething Beads. Staff stated further that the child is two-years-old and has been wearing them since she was an infant. The beads pose a safety risk of choking or strangulation.

- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation at the time of the survey, three staff were observed working in Room 114. A review of staff files found there was not a file for one of the staff observed in this classroom. An interview with the staff person in charge found this staff person had been sent from another facility as a substitute. The staff person in charge then contacted the other facility and had them e-mail the personnel file for this staff person while the surveyors were still present. A personnel file should be on cite at all times for a staff person working at a facility.
