- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, verification that fingerprint background checks had been initiated for two staff members with hire date of 8/16/2021 was not available at the time of the inspection. The staff member in charge acknowledged that the background checks had not been initiated. The staff members were not observed working alone with children.

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the employee files for two staff members with hire dates of 8/16/2021 did not contain a current statement from a health professional that the individuals are free of active tuberculosis; or a copy of negative tuberculin results. The staff member in charge acknowledged that the documentation was not available at the time of the survey.



435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the employee file for staff members with hire dates of 8/24/2017 and 8/23/2016 did not contain verification that that staff members had completed one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training within the past five (5) years. Review of ECE-TRIS also failed to verify completion of the aforementioned trainings. The staff member in charge acknowledged that the trainings had not been completed.
