- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (e) Manage the staff in their individual job descriptions;
- (f) Develop child-care center plans, policies, and procedures;
- (g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a caregiver hired on 2/28/95, used a cell phone during naptime in the preschool room on 09/17/15. Interview determined another caregiver used her cell phone while supervising children. The center's cell phone policy stated, "Due to the safety and supervision of our children, cell phones are prohibited in the classrooms and while you are supervising our children." Therefore, the cell phone policy was not implemented.

265 - Health, Safety, Comfort

Findings:

General: Based on interviews, a caregiver hired on 2/28/95, placed a four (4) year old child on the floor and placed both her legs over the child with a blanket on top of her legs which formed a tent over the child's body at naptime in a preschool room. Interviews determined the child cried and tried to get out, but would eventually fall asleep. Surveyor observed the four (4) year old child asleep on the floor with a blanket over her in the preschool room on 9/17/15.

Programming

385 - Discipline In Compliance

- (10) A child shall not be subjected to:
 - (a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);

- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a four (4) year old child slept on the floor during naptime in a preschool room on 9/17/15. Interview determined the child was placed on the floor and held down by a caregiver.
