General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor located a record indicating that the monthly fire drills and the quarterly tornado, earthquake, and shelter-in-place drills were completed during the month of August 2022. The provider was unable to locate documentation for the monthly fire drills or the quarterly tornado, earthquake, or shelter-in-place drills for the months of August 2021 and July 2022. The provider confirmed through interview that the fire drills were completed; however, the provider was unable to locate the records; therefore, the provider failed to maintain the written records as required.

The provider confirmed through interview that the fire drills were completed; however, the provider was unable to locate the records; therefore, the surveyor was unable to determine if monthly and quarterly drills were conducted as required.
