General: Based on observation and interview this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the men's bathroom on the top level of the facility, the surveyor observed masking tape being used to block off one of the sinks. The staff person in charge stated during interview that the sink was broken.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the two-year-old classroom in the basement, the surveyor observed two ceiling tiles in the classroom storage area that were discolored and bulging down towards the floor from an apparent water leak.

The cups did not contain a lid; therefore, there were no provisions to protect the milk from contamination.
