General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff member did not have a current annual performance evaluation on file at the facility. The evaluation in this staff members files was from 2019.

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff member did not have proof of education on file at the facility. The date of hire for this staff member is 10/05/2020.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) Two staff members did not complete Orientation I and II within the required three-month timeframe. One staff member hired on 09/01/2020, completed the training on 03/28/2021. The second staff member, who was hired on 10/05/2020, completed the training on 06/03/2021.
- 2.) One staff member hired on 01/15/2020, did not complete the required PAHT training within the first year of employment, the training was completed on 04/08/2021.
- 3.) One staff member hired on 08/27/2019, did not complete the required PAHT training. This staff member has been employed for more than one year.
- 4.) One staff member hired 01/15/2020, did not complete the required Orientation I and II courses. This staff member has been employed for more than three months.
- 5.) One staff member hired on 02/02/2018, completed PAHT training on 07/15/2013; however, did not renew the training that was due 07/15/2018.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The crock-pots in room 113 and in room 108 contained a white film along the interior sides of the pots. The crock-pots are used to heat the bottles.
- 2. The women and men's bathrooms, located in the basement, contained dusty ceiling vents.
- 3. The wooden cubbies located inside the 3rd floor stairwell contained tape residue on the surface.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility did not have a written policy that states that the procedures taught in the orientation training will be implemented by each child-care center staff member.

- (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility did not have the current rates for child-care posted in a conspicuous place for public inspection.

1215 - Daily Activities **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (h) Post a schedule of daily activities, to include dates and times of activities to be conducted with the children in each classroom;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the survey conducted on 5/28/2021, the posted lesson plans in two classrooms were no longer current. The posted lesson plans in the toddler III room (room 201) and in the Rising 3's room (room 208) were both dated 5/17/2021 to 5/21/2021.
