General: Based on observation, the surveyor found hand soap placed on the sink in the Sunshine Classroom that indicated keep out of reach of children; therefore, the item was accessible to the children and caused a potential health and safety issue for the children.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the following:

- A staff's (DOH: 12/10/19) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 10/8/20.
 A staff's (DOH: 10/28/86) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 4/28/20.
- 4. A staff's (DOH: 12/8/06) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 4/13/20.
- 5. A staff's (DOH: 12/1/04) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 4/16/20.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the following:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 3/1/97) personnel file contained a negative tuberculin result that was no longer current after 8/6/21.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 12/10/19) personnel file did not contain documentation confirming that the employee is free of active tuberculosis or provide a copy of a negative tuberculin result.

Therefore, the child-care center failed to show proof that the employees were free of active tuberculosis or provide a copy of a negative tuberculin result.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. Dirt/debris on the rugs located in the Harlan Classroom.
- 2. The sink in the girl's restroom located in the Harlan Classroom had brown spots on the sink top.
- 3. Fruit of the Loom Panty Packaging on the floor of the girls restroom located in the Sunshine Classroom.
- A disposable mask on the floor, beside of a brown child-size couch, located in the Sunshine Classroom.

Therefore, the premises was not kept clean.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the hot water temperature of the all the sinks located in the child-care center measured approximately sixty (60) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the water temperature of the sinks did not fall within the required minimum ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and maximum one hundred and twenty (120) degrees Fahrenheit. Staff stated that she would put a maintenance request in to correct the issue.
