- 2. A vacuum cleaner located beside the girls' restroom door in the Verda Head Start Classroom. The classroom was observed to be in operation.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (1) The premises shall be:
- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the sink located inside the Verda Head Start Classroom was observed to not have hot running water; therefore, the sink was not kept in good repair. The classroom was observed to be in operation and have children.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. Two (2) ceiling tiles in the boys' restroom located in the Verda Head Start Classroom that contained what appeared to be water stains; therefore, the ceiling tiles were not in good repair. The classroom was located between the Sunshine Head Start Classroom and Verda Head Start Classroom. Staff-in-charge stated that the classroom was currently closed to children
- 2. Two (2) ceiling tiles in the girls' restroom located in the Verda Head Start Classroom that contained what appeared to be water stains; therefore, the ceiling tiles were not in good repair. The classroom was located between the Sunshine Head Start Classroom and Verda Head Start Classroom. Staff-in-charge stated that the classroom was currently closed to children.
- 3. The black trim located at the bottom of the wall in the Verda Head Start Classroom by a purple/black table and on the wall beside the exit door was observed to be coming off the wall; therefore, the wall/trim was not in good repair. The classroom was located between the Sunshine Head Start Classroom and Verda Head Start Classroom. Staff-in-charge stated that the classroom was currently closed to children.
- 4. The drywall in the Gross Motor Room was observed to be torn in a straight line located toward the middle part of the wall; therefore, the wall was not in good repair.

690 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The hot water temperature at the small sink located in the Early Head Start Classroom measured at a temperature of approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the sink was not equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. The hot water temperature at the sink located in the restroom in the Early Head Start Classroom measured at a temperature of approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the sink was not equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 3. The hot water temperature at the sink located in the Sunshine Head Start Classroom measured at a temperature of approximately 75 degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the sink was not equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

695 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the girls' restroom located in the Verda Head Start Classroom; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair. The classroom was observed to be in operation.

- 2. Glass;
- 3. Rubbish; and
- 4. Flammable materials;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a wet paper towel located beside the fence roll by a chalk board on the Head Start Playground; therefore, the playground was not free from litter or rubbish.

795 - Playground Conditions

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the black material on both sides of the top step on the play structure that was located on the Head Start Playground was broken/cracked and exposed a sharp edge; therefore, the playground was not safe from foreseeable hazard.

805 - Fence Construction Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(24) Fences shall be:

- (a) Constructed of safe material;
- (b) Stable; and
- (c) In good condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The top pole was missing on part of the fence roll located in the back corner by a play structure on the Head Start Playground; therefore, the fence was not in good condition.
- 2. The chain link was observed to not be attached to the top pole located in the back corner by a swing set on the Head Start Playground; therefore, the fence was not in good condition.
