Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the little bathroom revealed a toilet bowl brush next to the toilets, accessible to children in care. Continued observation revealed in the Toddler classroom a plunger was located on the classroom sink that was accessible to children in care.

390 - Educational Requirements

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files revealed a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential was not presented for review at the time of survey for two (2) staff members hired 12/20/18 and 10/29/18. Interview with owner revealed she needed to obtain proof of education for these staff members.

395 - TB Verification

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files on 1/3/19 revealed three (3) staff members hired 9/30/14, 12/20/18 and 10/29/18 failed to have records of negative tuberculin result on file. Interview with owner revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

410 - Training

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed documentation of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for five (5) staff members hired 6/1/93, 2/3/00, 9/30/14, 9/19/16 and 4/28/16; additionally, nine (9) hours of cabinet approved training was not submitted for review for two staff members with the hire dates of 10/24/17 and 6/8/17. Continued review of staff files revealed six (6) staff member hired 6/1/93, 2/3/00, 10/24/17, 6/8/17, 9/19/16 and 4/28/16 had not received Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training PAHT. Review of staff files revealed three (1) staff members hired 10/24/17, 9/30/14 and 4/5/18 had not completed state approved orientation training. Interview with owner revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

Observation of Two's classroom revealed paint chipping and peeling from the wall behind the classroom door. Continued observation revealed in the Big bathroom paint chipping and peeling from the ceiling and walls.
