(1)(a) A provider shall complete annually at least nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training beginning with the second year of operation, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training in accordance with KRS 199.8982(2):

- 1. Within the second year of employment or operation in child care; and
- 2. Every subsequent five (5) years of employment or operation in child care.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider only completed three out of the required nine hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during her completed training year. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

525 - Outdoor Play Area Safe Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:100 - Section 11. The General Requirements of the Family Child-Care Home Environment.

(13) An outdoor play area shall be free of unavoidable danger or risk.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were unsafe in the outdoor play area:

- 1. The outdoor play area contained a section of barbed wire at the top of the fence that was adjacent to the outdoor play equipment.
- 2. The wooden border around the outdoor play area was in disrepair. Several sections of the border had fallen over and were broken. A broken section of the wooden border contained some exposed sharp rusted nails.

- (a) Designated by the manufacturer as developmentally appropriate to the age of children in care;
- (b) In sufficient quantity for the number of children in care; and
- (c) Safe, sound, clean, and in good repair.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Three of the swings in the outdoor play area contained chains with sharp broken plastic covers.

#### Transportation Not In Compliance

630 - Driver Requirements Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:100 - Section 17. Transportation.

- (9) A driver of a vehicle transporting a child for a certified provider shall:
- (a) Be at least twenty-one (21) years old;
- (b) Complete:
- 1. The background checks described in Section 2(2)(c)5 or 2(5) of this administrative regulation; and
- 2. An annual check of the:
- a. Kentucky driver history records in accordance with KRS 186.018; or
- b. Driver history records through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license;
- (c) Hold a current driver's license that has not been suspended or revoked during the last five (5) years; and
- (d) Not caused an accident which resulted in the death of a person.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider indicated that she sometimes transports children to the end of her road to a bus stop. The certified provider did not have a current driver history records check in accordance with KRS 186.018 or a driver history record through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A child enrolled on 1/02/18, did not have a current immunization certificate on file. The immunization certificate on file was only valid through 11/17/19.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider did not thave written evidence of submitting the emergency preparedness plan to the local emergency management officials, in accordance with KRS 199.895.

922 KAR 2:100 - Section 16. Animals.

- (1) An animal shall not be allowed in the presence of a child in care:
- (a) Unless:
- 1. The animal is under the supervision and control of an adult;
- 2. Written parental consent has been obtained; and
- 3. The animal is certified as vaccinated against rabies; or
- (b) Except in accordance with subsection (3) of this section.
- (2) A parent shall be notified in writing if a child has been bitten or scratched by an animal.
- (3) An animal that is considered undomesticated, wild, or exotic shall not be allowed at a certified family child-care home unless the animal is:
- (a) A part of a planned program activity led by an animal specialist affiliated with a zoo or nature conservatory; and
- (b) In accordance with 301 KAR 2:081 and 301 KAR 2:082.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The certified provider did not have a rabies vaccination certificate on file for her dog.
