General: Based on interview and review of documentation, three (3) staff members hired on 08/19/22, 08/26/22, and 09/01/22, did not have education verification on file.

- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, two (2) staff members hired on 08/19/22, and 08/26/22, did not have a TB skin test or a physician statement on file.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a staff member hired 08/01/17, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 08/16/17, and failed to complete the training again every five (5) years. A staff member hired 10/23/17, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 01/04/17, and failed to complete the training again every five (5) years.

General: Based on observation and interview, a container of Great Value disinfectant wipes was stored on the top shelf of a cabinet, which was three (3) feet from the floor, in the three-year-olds' classroom. The warning label stated, "Keep out of the reach of children."

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, eight (8) children were served French toast, sausage, a cup of orange slices, and milk for lunch in the four-year-olds' classroom, and ten (10) children were served French toast, sausage, a cup of orange slices, and milk for lunch in the three-year-olds' classroom. A serving of vegetables was not provided; therefore, the lunch meals did not meet meal requirements.
