Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a child enrolled 2/3/22, did not have an immunization certificate on file. A child enrolled 1/28/22, had an immunization certificate on file that was valid until 2/7/22.

2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the family child-care home; and

3. To contain:

(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;

(ii) Family physician; and

(iii) Preferred hospital;

c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;

d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:

(i) Allergies;

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the family child-care home;

e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;

f. Authorization by the parent for the provider to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on interview, the provider failed to maintain a written record for a child present in the home on 5/12/22, that was completed and signed by the parent, retained the first day enrolled to include identifying information about the child, contact information to enable the provider to contact the child's parent, family physician and preferred hospital, the name of each person designated in writing to pick up the child, the child's general health status and medical history, the name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving the child and authorization by the parent for the provider to seek emergency medical care for the child in the absence of the parent.
