(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who ensures the child is:
- a. Within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

Findings:

General: Based on a review of documentation, interview and observation, a caregiver, hire date 10/06/11, laid on the floor in the book area between two (2) children at approximately 12:30 pm to rub their backs during nap time. A second caregiver, hire date 08/22/14, left the room at 1:00 pm for an hour lunch break. The caregiver hired 10/06/11 could not adequately supervise the other children in the classroom from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm while she laid on the floor. Observation determined the book area was in the corner of the classroom with one (1) side blocked by a bookshelf and another side blocked by a cabinet; therefore, the children outside the book area were not within the caregiver's scope of vision.

Findings:

General: Based on a review of documentation and interview, minimum staff/child ratio and maximum group size were not maintained at all times on 03/22/18. Two (2) caregivers were responsible for eleven (11), one-year-old children in room 104 on 03/22/18. Caregiver, hire date 08/22/14, took an hour lunch break at 1:00 pm leaving the second caregiver, hire date 10/06/11, alone with the eleven (11) children. One (1) child was removed from the room at 1:50 pm and a second child was picked-up before 2:00 pm. This left the staff member with nine (9) children until 2:00 pm when caregiver, hire date 08/22/14, returned from the lunch break.

General: Based on a review of documentation and interview, a check mark on the classroom check sheet indicated a child was present in room 104 on 03/22/18. A review of the DCC-94E Child Care Daily Attendance Record reflected this child's name was listed, but an arrival and departure time were not documented. Interviews with caregivers confirmed the child was present in room 104.
