General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a child enrolled on 08/07/20, had an immunization certificate on file that was valid until 06/20/21. A child enrolled on 12/15/20/20, had an immunization certificate on file that was valid until 11/02/21. A child enrolled on 09/21/21, had an immunization certificate on file that was valid until 12/15/21.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, three (3) children enrolled on 08/07/20, 07/17/19 and 09/21/21, enrollment information did not include the health status on allergies.

1305 - Fire Drills

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a monthly, practiced fire drill was conducted in November 2021, but the date, time and name of children participants were not documented.

- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.
- (13) An earthquake drill, shelter-in-place or lockdown drill, and tornado drill shall be:

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a monthly, practiced fire drill was conducted in November 2021, but was not documented.
