Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, staff hired on 8/21/2020, 9/1/2020, 10/26/2020, and 4/1/2021, did not have the results of background checks before being left alone with children. The surveyor observed the staff working alone with children during the inspection.

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff hired on 9/1/2020, and one staff hired on 4/1/2021, did not have a personnel file available for review.

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff hired on 9/1/2020, and one staff hired on 4/1/2021, did not have proof of education.

- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, a staff person hired on 7/31/2019, and two staff hired on 9/1/2020, have yet to complete the six hour early care and orientation training.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:415E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a total of six staff (one hired on 8/21/2020, two staff hired 9/1/2020, and three staff hired the dates of 10/1/2020, 10/26/2020, and 4/1/2021) did not have the results or proof of submission for the Criminal Background Checks as well as Child Abuse and Neglect Checks (CAN).

Additionally, staff hired on 8/1/2017, 8/1/2020, and two on 9/1/2020, have yet to complete the mandatory training on cleaning, sanitizing, health procedures, and mandatory reporting.
