Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A set of approximately nine (9) wooden steps that lead from the provider's deck down to the outdoor play area used by the children was not safe. The wooden steps were not gated at the bottom, so the children had access to the staircase when they were inside the outdoor play area. The certified provider cares for toddlers. In addition, there was a gap between the wooden rails and the steps on the sides of the staircase, where the children would be able to climb through as well.

Findings

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A Little Tikes multi-colored climbing cube with a slide was located in the back corner of the outdoor play area used by the children. The climber with a slide was located on dirt and some grass was observed around the perimeter of the apparatus. The climber was approximately 4.50 feet tall. The certified provider cares for toddlers. Due to the height of the climber, and it being located on dirt, this did not provide a sufficient cushioned fall material for the apparatus. The certified provider stated that this climber with slide was not the same climber with slide that she was cited for last year for not having the appropriate surfacing under the apparatus. The certified provider stated that she got rid of the climber that was cited last year for not being on the appropriate cushioned material, and replaced it with this apparatus that she had before. The certified provider indicated that she thought this one was okay.
