(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who:
- a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the toddler teacher left five (5) toddlers unsupervised in the hallway outside of the classroom door while she went back into the classroom to retrieve some items. Four (4) children were buckled into a buggy and one (1) toddler child was observed to be standing at the back side of the buggy. The children were unsupervised for approximately one (1) minute.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that out of twenty (20) staff files reviewed, eight (8) staff files did not have evidence of an annual performance evaluation.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (I) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the three (3) high chairs that are used to feed the infant children had no safety straps.

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that out of twenty (20) staff files reviewed, three (3) staff files did not have evidence of proof of education. The dates of hire for the staff were 07/18/2016, 02/06/2017 and 11/2016.

320 - TB Verification **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found through a review of twenty (20) staff files that four (4) staff files had no evidence of being free of TB. The dates of hire for the staff were 10/23/2016, 11/2016, 10/16/2014 and 08/25/2014.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found through a review of twenty (20) staff files that seven (7) staff files did not have record of the fifteen (15) hours of cabinetaproved early care and education training. It was found that a staff person with a hire date of 01/20/2015 did not have evidence of pediatric abusive head trauma training. It was found that a staff person with a hire date of 07/18/2016 did not have evidence of the six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training. It was found that a staff person with a hire date of 08/12/2016 did not complete orientation training until 12/10/2016 and a staff person with a hire date of 06/27/2016 did not complete orientation training until 12/15/2016. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this.

General: Based on Interview, it was found in an interview with a staff person in the Infant classroom that the toys are only cleaned with a bleach water solution. It was found that the toys in the Toddler classroom are cleaned with disinfectant spray.
