It should be noted that there were extra staff members in the building that could have assisted with the classroom.</p>

General: Based on observation, the children in the Three's classroom did not wash their hands prior to eating their lunch. The children went straight from playing in the classroom to sitting down and eating.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the cots in the Two's classroom were stacked in the corner with sheets and blankets touching each other. This is not a proper method of storage, as it promotes the spread of germs and bacteria.

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865 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

General: Based on observation, a bench in the Three's classroom had a heavily soiled cushion on top.

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulation was not met. The teachers indicated that they only serve the children what their parents bring and the majority of the children were missing one or more components. One child had a peanut butter sandwich, gummies, fruit roll up, and chips. Another child had a fruit cup, 2 crackers, a slice of cheese, an Oreo, and granola bar. If the meal is provided by the parent, the provider must supplement the child's meal if it is missing any components.
