- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

435 - Training

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the staff in charge did not provide verification that the employees with the hire dates of 04/26/2012,04/18/2016, 05/13/2019 and 10/21/2020 had met the requirement of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during the last year of employment. Continued review revealed the employee with the hire date of 10/21/2020 had not completed Orientation and Pediatric Head Training training within the required timeframes. Review of documentation in the ECE-TRIS training system revealed the staff members listed above had not met the requirements.

- (3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 3. No bedding other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a four-month-old and an eleven-month-old infant were sleeping in separate cribs with loose bedding.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the ceiling tiles in the infant restroom and in the four and five-year-old classroom contained brown stains that were indicative of water stains.

690 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the handwashing sink in the two-year-old classroom was not equipped with hot, running water. The water temperature was sixty-two (62) degrees Fahrenheit.

- 5. Easily cleaned; and
- 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the changing pad located in the infant classroom had duct tape on the bottom of the pad and the vinyl did not completely cover the area underneath. Continued observation revealed the top of the pad was ripped, exposing the material inside. Therefore, the changing pads were not kept in a hygienic manner.
