General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor arrived at 2:00PM, and observed three preschool children sleeping directly on the living room floor. The children were sharing two pillows and had one blanket lying over top of all three of them. Individual beds, cots, or mats were not available to them and individual pillows and blankets were not provided.
