- (9) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 1. An individual non-tiered crib that meets Consumer Product Safety Commission standards established in 16 C.F.R. 1219-1220;
- 2. A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that is changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;
- 3. No loose bedding, such as a bumper or a blanket; and
- 4. No toys or other items except for the infant's pacifier; or

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview with the staff in charge, a three-month-old infant was in care during the renewal. According to interview the infant has been enrolled for about a month and does not have a crib for napping. The staff in charge indicated that the infant sleeps in a bouncy seat or a car seat carrier.

General: Based on interview, the staff in charge was unable to locate the certified provider's insurance, registration, and a copy of her driver's license. The staff in charge stated that the certified provider picks children up from three (3) elementary schools each day around 2:30 PM.

- (9) A driver of a vehicle transporting a child for a certified provider shall:
- (a) Be at least twenty-one (21) years old;
- (b) Complete:
- 1. The background checks described in Section 2(2)(c)5 or 2(5) of this administrative regulation; and
- 2. An annual check of the:
- a. Kentucky driver history records in accordance with KRS 186.018; or
- b. Driver history records through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license;
- (c) Hold a current driver's license that has not been suspended or revoked during the last five (5) years; and
- (d) Not caused an accident which resulted in the death of a person.

General: Based on interview with the staff in charge, the certified provider picks children up from three (3) elementary schools around 2:30 PM each day. Review of documentation presented found that the certified provider did not have a copy of an annual check of the Kentucky driver history records in accordance with KRS 186.018 or a driver history records check through the state transprotation agency that issued the driver's license.
