Observation of the infant room revealed a sleeping infant in a crib with a pacifier in their mouth that was attached to the clothing. Interview with a staff member revealed the sleeping infant was four (4) months old.

Observation of the tigger tots room revealed carpeting soiled with an orange substance.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the shining stars' room revealed an area of wall that exposed particle board and had chipped paint. Continued observation of the shining stars' room revealed the baseboard not secured to the wall by the dress up area.
