Also, the plastic-coated wire mesh on the baby gate was broken in several areas causing the wire mesh to protrude and contain sharp pointed edges; 2. There was a screw protruding from the wooden frame of a changing table causing the changing table not to be stable, that was located within the Girl's hallway bathroom; 3. There were two (2) infant plastic swings located on the Infant/Toddler outside playground with nylon ropes that were attached to both swings that were rotted and frayed; and 4. There was a metal truck located on the Preschool/School-Age outside playground that was missing a steering wheel leaving the area with sharp edges.
