## Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. During an inspection of the kitchen, the surveyor only found whole milk available to serve to the children in care that were 24-months and older. The staff person in charge acknowledged the finding and stated that she was not able to purchase 1% milk during her recent trip to the grocery store.
