General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff (DOH: 08/19/20) file did not contain documentation of a current TB skin test or a statement from a health professional stating that the adult was free from active tuberculosis.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found that the following staff (DOH: 12/25/16, 05/23/19, 08/03/21, 08/06/12, 11/15/21, 10/25/21 and 11/02/21) had not completed the required CPR/First Aid Training.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found that a staff (DOH: 07/12/16) completed one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training on 03/13/17; therefore, the training was not completed within the last five years.

- 2. The following children's (DOE: 03/16/20 and 01/17/22) file did not contain the name of the child's preferred hospital.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the child-care center had not conducted the required lockdown drill for 2021 or 2022; therefore, the child-care center failed to conduct and record the required lockdown drill.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that they had not completed the lockdown drills due to trying to have an intercom system installed to make it easier for staff to hear when an intruder has entered the building.
