Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and observation, a caregiver hired on 8/8/18, had not submitted their fingerprint at an authorized collection site for the NBCP. The caregiver was present with a qualified staff member.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, three (3) school-aged children were observed in the hallway and were not within a caregiver's scope of vision or range of voice. Interview with the director determined it was common practice for a child to walk another child to the check out area without adult staff supervision.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 7/30/17, had TB documentation dated 2/3/16. A caregiver hired on 8/7/17, had TB documentation dated 10/5/16.
