1. High school diploma:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 10/28/21 and 10/25/21, each did not have documentation of education on file. A caregiver hired on 10/14/21, had an unofficial transcript on file that did not indicate the highest level of education completed.
