922 KAR 2:090. Section 6. License Issuance.

- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) employee files (hire dates: 1/15/16 and 8/17/16) contained criminal records checks that were dated 1/28/16 and 9/18/16. There was no documentation on file to verify if their criminal records checks were requested prior to hire as required by KRS 199.896(19). File review found that an employee hired on 12/19/16 currently lives in the state of Ohio. This employee did not have an out of state background check on file. It is important to note that this individual was not observed working alone with children during the inspection.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) employee files (Hire dates: 11/30/16 and 12/19/16) did not contain proof of education.

320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) employee files (hire dates: 9/30/15 and 12/19/16) did not contain TB skin documentation. One (1) employee file (hire date: 1/15/16) had TB skin documentation on file dated 2/17/16. The documentation was obtained after the employee's date of hire.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the surveyor observed a gallon of bleach and a roll of black trash bags underneath the hand-washing sink cabinet. The cabinet doors were not secured; therefore, the items were accessible to the children in care.

- (4) A cold-storage facility used for storage of perishable food in a nonfrozen state shall:
- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the surveyor found that there was not a temperature measuring device located in the refrigerator. The refrigerator contained snack items such as Apple Juice.

1050 - Menu Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 9. Food and Meal Requirements.

- (16) A weekly menu shall be:
- (a) Prepared;(b) Dated;
- (c) Posted in advance in a conspicuous place;
- (d) Kept on file for thirty (30) days; and

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the facility failed to prepare, date, and post a snack menu. The surveyor observed a blank snack document posted on the wall during the inspection.
