Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Upon entering the transition room at 9:08 a.m. the surveyor observed fourteen (14) children with two (2) staff members. After the surveyor started counting the children a staff member picked up a child up and handed her / him over a half door to a staff member in the two-year-old room. The staff member then handed a second child over the half wall to a staff member in the two-year-old room. Interview with a staff member revealed the youngest age child in the transition room was one-year-old. When the surveyor entered the two-year-old room the two (2) children who were handed over the half door were observed in the room.

350 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) A director shall:
- (I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Review of an accident report revealed a child lost his balance on a vent and hit his front teeth on the wall. Interviews and observation revealed the top of the vent was not in good repair causing the one-year-old child to trip and hit his front teeth on the wall. Continued interviews revealed dental treatment was sought for the one-year-old child for the pain and discomfort from one of the teeth that hit the wall when he tripped over the vent.

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (1) The premises shall be:
- (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
- (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the one-year-old room revealed the floor vent covers had a piece of screen covering them. Continued observation revealed a floor vent cover by the window had screen that was not secured to the vent. Continued observation revealed portions of the screen on the floor vent cover were wrinkled up and folded over, causing a tripping hazard.
