2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or

3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. A staff member with a hire date of 2/18/2019 did not have any verification of a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential in their personnel file. In addition, the director acknowledged there was no document to verify the education of the above-mentioned staff member on the date of survey.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. A current statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis or a current copy of negative tuberculin results was not presented for review at the time of survey for two (2) staff members with hire dates of 2/18/19 and 3/6/19. In addition, the director revealed this documentation was not available for review at the time of survey the two (2) aforementioned staff members.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

410 - Training

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. The child care center did not produce verification from the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) that a staff member with a hire date of 9/24/18 had completed six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training. In addition, the director disclosed that the child care center could not produce supporting documentation that the orientation training had been completed.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. In both the Boys and Girls bathrooms, there were browncolored, water stains on several ceiling tiles. In addition, there were brown-colored, water stains on several ceiling tiles in the Toddler room, the Nursery room, and the Pre-K room.

#### 580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. Specifically, in the Nursery room, there was chipped/peeled paint on the walls.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulations. In the Nursery room, the bottles located in the refrigerator were included in a plastic bag that was labeled per student; however, the bottles themselves were not individually labeled. In addition, the director acknowledged that if the Nursery room became crowded, it would be difficult to distinguish to whom a bottle belonged to.
