### Findings:

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

General: Based on observation, a spray cleaner and a staff members McDonald's cup was observed on a low shelving unit within the Two-to-Four-Year-Old classroom.

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) A water-stained ceiling tile was observed in the Boy's restroom area.
- 2.) The ceiling tile support rails within the School-Age classroom were bowing and in disrepair. The ceiling tiles were drooping as a result.
- 3.) A wall in the Toddler classroom had several small indentations and was not smooth.
- 4.) A wall in the School-Age classroom was streaked with a sticky residue and areas of grime.
- 5.) A wall in the School-Age classroom had a large crack.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the staff person in the Two-to-Four-Year-Old classroom stated that she does not usually have children who are not yet potty-trained in her classroom. The staff person stated that she has been completing diaper changes on the floor of the classroom. A changing mat was not available for diaper changes.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, three small climbing structures located on the playground were placed closely to the fence and wall areas. The fall zone around the structures did not match or exceed the height of the climbing equipment.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

# Findings:

General: Based on observation, a shelving unit within the Toddler classroom had tape residue and light brown stains.

## 865 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, a large climbing apparatus on the playground was in disrepair. A portion of the play structure was detached.
