b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

## Findings:

5 - Children Supervised

General: Based on Interview and Review of Documentation, the child care center failed to maintain adequate supervision in accordance with regulations. Interviews with multiple staff members revealed on 12/18/15, a one-year-old walked out of the classroom and into the hallway unsupervised when either a teacher or parent opened the classroom door. Continued interview with staff members revealed the one-year-old was left unsupervised in the hallway for an undetermined amount of time, ranging from less than one (1) minute-two (2) minutes, before being returned to her classroom by either a teacher or the child's mother. Review of documentation was consistent with interviews.
