(8) Each center shall ensure that every staff member has received training on first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 03/09/22, 06/01/21, and 05/18/21, did not complete the required CPR and First Aid training. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed this finding.



435 - Training Not In Compliance

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

1) Staff member hired on 03/09/22, did not complete the required Orientation. This staff member has been employed for more than 3 months.

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2) Staff hired on 02/22/21, did not have any cabinet-approved early care and education training hours on file.

The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed these findings.
