General: Based on observation, two (2) staff hired on 10/17/19 and 8/27/19, did not have education documentation on file.

- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, staff hired 10/17/19; 8/27/19; 10/28/19 and 7/18/19, did not have TB documentation on file. Staff hired 7/26/17, TB skin test was dated 8/8/17. A volunteer start dated 11/1/19. TB skin test was dated 8/10/15.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, staff hired 7/18/19 and 3/27/18, did not complete six (6) hours of orientation training within the first three (3) months of their employment. Staff hired 6/26/18 completed orientation training on 10/8/18, which was not within the first three (3) months of employment. Staff hired 3/14/17, completed eight (8) hours of child development training. Staff hired 4/9/10, completed fourteen and a half (14.50) of child development training. Staff hired 1/31/05, completed one and a half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training on 3/11/13 and did not complete the training every five (5) years afterwards. Staff hired 6/26/18, did not complete one and a half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training.

General: Based on observation, the hot water registered sixty (60) degrees Fahrenheit at a sink in classroom 103. Also, the hot water registered eighty (80) degrees Fahrenheit at two (2) handwashing sinks adjaceant to classroom 103.
