General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the surveyor found that a staff file (DOH: 9/6/12) did not contain an annual evaluation. Upon interview, Staff-in-Charge was not aware that an evaluation was missing from the file and stated it is likely due to the staff member being a substitute.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, review of ECE-TRIS, and interview, the surveyor found that a staff file (DOH: 8/17/16) contained documentation that Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma (PAHT) training was last completed on 8/20/13; therefore, PAHT had not been completed every five (5) years as required. Staff-in-charge was not aware that the staff member had not completed PAHT every five (5) years.

- (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and
- (d) Unless the child-care center is a before- or after-school program that operates part day or less, that offers a variety of creative activities including:
- 1. Art or music;
- 2. Math or numbers;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the weekly lesson plan posted in the Part Day classroom was not dated. Staff stated that the lesson plan posted was the current lesson plan for the week but they had failed to date it.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the sink in the restroom located off of the Part Day classroom was soiled with dust, black smudges, and food. Staff stated that the restroom is cleaned daily after breakfast and after lunch.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the toilet in the restroom located off of the Part Day classroom had dried urine on the base where it is bolted to the floor. Staff reported that the restroom is cleaned daily after breakfast and after lunch.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the surveyor found that there were fourteen (14) children present in the Part Day classroom but only seven (7) were signed in on the daily sign in log located in the classroom. Staff-in-charge reported that the other children ride the bus and are signed on and off the bus by their parents on the on/off log for the bus; therefore, the children are not signed in or out on the daily sign in sheet in the classroom.
