#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, at approximately 4:20 p.m. a staff member stood at the door way of the Cafeteria/Room #1 while two (2) children used the two (2) restrooms across from the room. Continued observation revealed the restrooms were located approximately sixteen (16) paces away from the Cafeteria/Room #1. Further observation revealed when entering either of the two (2) restrooms the children had to turn a corner to enter into the restrooms which prevented the staff member from providing adequate supervision.
