Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and Interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files revealed a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis or a copy of negative tuberculin results was not presented for review at the time of survey for a staff member hired 10/17/16. Interview with staff-in-charge revealed this documentation was not available for review at the time of survey.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and Interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files revealed documentation of pediatric abusive head trauma training (PAHT) was not presented for review at the time of survey for the director hired 10/5/15. Interview with staff-in-charge revealed the director has not completed the PAHT.
