Review of the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) report did not verify that the six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training had been completed by the staff members.

- 2. Written parental consent has been obtained; and
- 3. The animal is certified as vaccinated against rabies; or
- (b) Except in accordance with subsection (3) of this section.

Findings:

General: Observation of the child care center revealed there was one (1) fish and several snails within a fish tank that was accessible to the children. Upon request, written parental consent was not obtained for all of the children at the child care center.
