Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the visit, it was found that four (4) staff members were supervising a group of twenty-five (25) children on the playground (age range: 2 - 3 years). Staff stated that three (3) different classrooms were present. The surveyor observed these three (3) groups together from approximatley 10:15AM - 10:47PM. The youngest child in the group was two (2) year old, making the maximum group size twenty (20). The facility exceeded the group size by five (5) children.

- (b) Pasteurized whole milk for children ages twelve (12) months to twenty-four (24) months; or
- (c) Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor observed 2% milk being served to the preschool children (three (3) – five (5) year olds) during lunch.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. One (1) child (enrollment date: 10/5/16) had an immunization certificate on file that was no longer current as of 1/1/19. The staff person in charge stated that she was in process of obtaining current documentation for this child.
