- 1) A staff member's purse was sitting on top of a low shelf in the two-year-old classroom. The purse was accessible to the children.
- 2). The door leading into the break room was open and a spray bottle labeled bleach solution and a container of disinfecting wipes were both found on a table. Also in the break room, there was a gray metal cabinet that was unlocked and inside were containers of disinfecting wipes. These items were all accessible to the children.
