General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the Fire Marshal report was dated 3/9/2020. Staff-in-charge stated the fire marshal had been to the location since the 3/9/2020 date; however, she stated she thought the new certificate was sent to an old email address.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor discovered the liquid hand soap was placed on a sink was accessible to the children in the restroom located furthest from the Art Room entrance. The label on the hand soap indicated "keep out of reach of children"; thus, the liquid hand soap was accessible to the children which causes a potential health and safety issue for the children.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered that a child's (DOE: 8/31/22) immunization certificate was no longer current as of 9/6/22.

- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered that the file presented for review for a child (DOE: 8/31/22) did not contain the name or telephone number for the family physician or the name or telephone number for the preferred hospital; therefore, the child-care center failed to maintain the child's record.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the written logs for the drills and the documentation provided by the child-care center to the surveyor for review did not indicate that lockdown/shelter-in-place drills were conducted.

Staff-in-charge stated the child-care center had been conducting the drills; however, she stated she must have forgotten to document the drills.
