Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the files for four (4) employees hired after 1-1-2009 did not contain evidence of a high school diploma, GED or Commonwealth Childcare Credential.

395 - TB Verification **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the following was found: 1) the file for an employee hired on 1-24-12 contained the results of a TB skin test that was read on 7-1-15. This date is not within the two (2) year timeframe required by the regulation; 2) the file for an employee hired on 8-15-18 contained the results of a TB skin test that were read on 8-17 -18. This date is not prior to the date of hire as required by the regulation; 3) the files for employees hired on 8-1-17 and 8-15-18 did not contain the results of a TB skin test or screening.



410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the files and ECE-TRIS records for two (2) employees hired on 8-1-17 did not contain evidence of Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training being completed within the first year of employment. The files and ECE-TRIS records for employees hired on 8-1-17 and 9-1-17 did not contain evidence of the six (6) hour cabinet-approved orientation training being completed. The file and ECE-TRIS record for an employee hired on 8-12-15 contained evidence of only eight and a half hours of training being completed during the last completed training year.
