Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for five (5) staff members with hire dates 09/27/2010, 12/01/2014, 11/07/2012, 12/02/2010 and 03/06/2006.

Interview with the director revealed the requested documentation was unavailable at the time or survey.
