In the infant room there was a broken floor tile near the closet door.

- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the refrigerator located in the nursery area revealed no thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device was present.

940 - Frozen Food Not In Compliance

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the freezer area located in the nursery revealed no thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device was present.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. The file for a child with the enrollment date of 09/05/2017 did not contain a preferred hospital.
