922 KAR 2:120. Section 9. Food and Meal Requirements.

- (3) A serving of milk shall consist of:
- (a) Breast milk or iron-fortified formula for a child:
- 1. Age birth to twelve (12) months; or
- 2. Beyond twelve (12) months of age as documented by the parent or the child's physician;
- (b) Pasteurized whole milk for children ages twelve (12) months to twenty-four (24) months; or
- (c) Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that school-age children drink 2% milk, not 1% or skim milk as required by the regulations.

#### Findings:

General: Based on interview, the staff person in charge could not locate the facility's emergency preparedness plan.

1195 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.
- (13) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found fire, earthquake, and tornado drills were not practiced or documented as required by the regulations.

The documentation presented for review found that fire drills were only completed in August 2019 and September 2020, and earthquake and tornado drills were only completed in August 2019.
