General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed one (1) staff member with hire date 8/23/10 had completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training PAHT on 8/14/12. Interview with director revealed the staff member hired 8/23/10 had not completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training PAHT training after 8/14/12. Therefore the PAHT training completed on 8/14/12 was no longer current as it was older than five years.
