General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) The employee bathroom door was open and there was a container of Lysol wipes, Lysol spray and Febreze sitting on the countertop. There was also a container of bleach and a can of paint found in an unlocked sink cabinet. The staff person in charge stated that the children do not use that bathroom but the door was found open and it is next to the hallway the children use daily.
- There were Plug In air fresheners in numerous outlets in all of the classrooms and children's bathrooms. The Plug Ins contain a clear liquid substance.
- 3) A staff purse was found in an unlocked bottom drawer of the changing table in the infant classroom.
- All of the items listed were accessible to the children.
